From the Officials

Pee Wee (1st & 2nd Grades)

Emphasis: Playing time and teaching rules. Instruction will be provided to player by Officials regarding foul at hand. Fouls will be called when they are “plain to see” by the attending Official.

Enforcement will become stricter as season progresses.

Infraction/Foul emphasis: traveling, double dribble, jump ball, reaching inside, hacking.

Time outs: (2) per half with a maximum of (4) per game

Shooting fouls: Foul shots will be taken at the end of regulation play

Flagrant fouls and other forms of misconduct: Officials have the discretion to sub-out offending player(s).

3rd & 4th Grade

Emphasis: Teaching rules and consistent rule enforcement. Brief instruction will be provided to player by Officials regarding foul at hand. Fouls will be called when they are “plain to see” by the attending Official.

Infraction/Foul emphasis: traveling, double dribble, jump ball, 3 second violation, reaching inside, hacking.

Time outs: (2) per half with a maximum of (4) per game

Shooting fouls: Foul shots will be taken at the end of regulation play

Flagrant fouls and other forms of misconduct: Officials have the discretion to sub-out offending player(s).

5th & 6th Grade

Emphasis: Consistent rule enforcement and normalized play. Fouls will be called when they are “plain to see” by the attending Official.

Infraction/Foul emphasis: travel, double dribble, jump ball, 3 second violation, reaching inside, hacking.

Time outs: (2) per half with a maximum of (4) per game

Shooting fouls: Foul shots will be taken at the end of regulation play

Flagrant fouls and other forms of misconduct: Officials have the discretion to sub-out offending player(s).
